Comprehensive Care Capitation Payment Increases effective January 1, 2008:

The 2004 Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (MOHLTC) and the Ontario Medical Association (OMA) includes provisions for an increase in the value Comprehensive Care Capitation Payment effective January 1, 2008. We are pleased to advise you that this increase has been processed and was reflected on your February 2008 Remittance Advice (RA).

Effective January 1, 2008 the average monthly payment has been increased to \$2.15 per rostered patient.

If you receive comprehensive care capitation payments on your group RA, this payment will be reported and paid on your February 2008 group RA.

If you receive comprehensive care capitation payments on your solo RA, this payment will be reported and paid on your February 2008 solo RA.
