

Primary Care Consent Data Reports

The Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (ministry) is replacing the Consent Data Report with the Outside Use Report (Consented Patients). This report details outside primary care services for enrolled patients who have granted consent for the release of specific types of personal health information.

The Outside Use Report (Consented Patients) no longer details claims that do not contribute to the outside use payment calculation or impact access bonus payments. Therefore, preventive care, ocular-visual assessments and services provided by an identified General Practitioner (GP) Psychotherapist no longer appear on the report.

The claims information appearing on the Outside Use Report (Consented Patients) does not include services of patients who did not provide consent nor does it include sensitive services, ie urine pregnancy test (G005), vaginal swabs – fungal (G011) or vaginal swab – wet prep (G012). For this reason, it cannot be used to reconcile to monthly outside use totals.

The patients have authorized the ministry to release this information to their primary care physicians by signing the *Consent to Release Personal Health Information form, the Patient Enrolment Form and Consent to Release Personal Health Information or the Patient Enrolment and Consent to Release Personal Health Information Form*.
